**A note about training fees:**

The leadership has given considerable thought to this year's budget and how to price the training fees for the 2009-2010 season. Although our budget calls for a more significant increase, we have chosen to hold the increase to 5%, a number which is less than adequate to balance our budget. There are several reasons we are choosing this course; first, our primary concern is for how the downturn in the economy is affecting our members and we are trying to minimize the impact of our training fees on your budget. We're also hopeful that our seasonal events (ski swap, auction, races, etc) will be more successful than budgeted and will carry additional revenue to offset training fees. Since the club cannot afford losses of any kind, we want the membership to know how vitally important the success of these programs are for the benefit of our members, without them, our training fees would more than double to provide the coaching and equipment to run our program. Since we are a volunteer organization, it's up to each and every one of us to do what we can to support the club in our own way. For some, a financial contribution is the easiest route while others volunteering time to work on an event or committee is more fitting. Regardless of your situation, we are always in need of assistance.

Two specific programs/ events that have the biggest financial impact are our annual auction and corporate sponsorship program. If we can put the necessary energy and excitement into those two programs/events, we can close the gap in our budget fairly quickly. If you feel you can make a difference in either of those areas please contact me, I'd love to have your involvement.

I'd be remiss if I didn't mention that our current members and alumni can also make gifts to the club to help support specific goals or contribute to our current operating costs. We have received generous gifts in the past which allows us to afford the quality and quantity of coaches we hire to train our athletes. We would be grateful for any additional help you can provide. FSC survives on the combined effort of its members and we are appreciative of your help.

## **FSC MIDWEEK SKI TRAINING 2009-2010**

For the past several seasons, FSC has offered a mid-week training schedule that has been successful for the athletes, coaching staff and parents; we are pleased to once again outline our midweek offerings for the 2009-2010 ski season. The leadership of the club wants to make known our continued desire to meet the needs of our members and midweek training is a way for FSC athletes to keep pace with the accelerating demands of ski racing and advanced race training without the full time commitment or the financial burden of a ski academy or prep school.

Last season we added an opportunity for JV athletes to train the Fridays prior to qualifying races and championship events. Because of the success of those training days, they will be offered again this season.

Our mid-week training accommodates the needs of our JI, JII and JIII, JIV and JV athletes. For several seasons now, we have offered a full day Friday session with the hopes it would be easier for families to coordinate with their schools and also provide the club with a better opportunity to provide a structured program for a more sizable group. This Friday full day session is popular and we hope to continue to build on that strength.

### **The Specifics:**

#### **JI & JII**

FSC offers training for JI & JII athletes Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday mornings from 9:00-12:00 and full days on Friday. We have learned from the successes at the JIV and JIII levels that the low athlete to coach ratios on midweek days significantly improves results for the athletes. We are putting considerable effort into expanding this area of the ski club curriculum.

The cost will be \$35 per ½ day, \$65 per full day, \$510 per season for full day Friday sessions or full time midweek season of \$2683, in addition to the weekend training fees. There is a limit of 13 midweek training days on a per diem basis. Athletes wishing to ski additional days should sign up for the full time midweek program.

This is an outstanding opportunity as the club will have experienced coaches on the hill who are also working with our athletes on the weekend. The transition between midweek and weekend training is seamless and the training is of the highest quality available.

#### **JIII**

Like the JI/JII midweek training program, the JIII program offers an intensive full day Friday program and a full-time midweek program. For the athlete that wants a full day Friday concentrated program, it is available with a coach on staff that focuses primarily on gate training in both the morning and afternoon sessions. Also for the athlete whose schedule allows for a full time training regiment, FSC offers training Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday afternoons from 1:00 to 3:30. They train in conjunction with the Holderness School athletes and coaches.

The cost will be \$35 per ½ day, \$65 per full day, \$510 per season for full day Friday sessions or full time midweek season of \$2347, in addition to the weekend training fees. There is a limit of 13 midweek training days on a per diem basis. Athletes wishing to ski additional days should sign up for the full time midweek program.

This is an outstanding opportunity as the club will have experienced coaches on the hill who are also working with our athletes on the weekend. The transition between midweek and weekend training is seamless and the training is of the highest quality available.

## **JIV**

The JIV midweek training program is based on our successful full day Friday session. The training will be 9:00-12:00 and 1:00 to 3:30. The cost will be \$35 per ½ day, \$65 per full day or \$510 per season in addition to the weekend training fees.

This full day Friday training is designed for athletes who want substantial on-snow time and don't want the commitment of a Prep School or Ski Academy. The athlete who skis a full day on Friday, Saturday and Sunday, is receiving nearly as much training time as a Prep School athlete would receive spread over the a weeks time. For that reason, highly motivated athletes skiing in our Friday program have had great success on the hill.

## **JV**

The Friday training for JV athletes is scheduled immediately prior to JV qualifiers and championship events. Last season we have offered this option with great success. We are once again making these race prep days available as a formal offering so that parents can better plan their schedules.

The training will be 9:00-12:00 and 1:00-3:30. The cost will be \$35 per ½ day, \$65 per full day in addition to the weekend training fees. Like the weekend program, parents are responsible for the JV athletes during the lunch hour and it is a good idea if your child has the ability to contact you in case they have needs throughout the day.

The JV training days are: January 29, February 12, February 26\*, March 5\* and March 12.

\* School vacation weeks - no charge to train these days

## **RACE WORKER CREDITS**

FSC members with racers enrolled are expected to work the equivalent of **seven (7) race credits**. Each race worked is equal to one (1) race credit. Races provide income to the club that heavily offset the cost of training fees. Although not encouraged, families may elect not to work the races by paying \$900.00 in advance. Families not fulfilling their race worker obligation and not paying the fee in advance will be assessed a penalty of \$200 per credit.

- Race work includes registration, course maintenance, gate keeping, timing, scoring, food table etc.
- Race credits may also be earned by **working** on fundraising activities.
- Race worker educational opportunities on the hill will be held December 31<sup>st</sup>.
- Race workers must sign in and out on race day.
- Race workers receive a voucher. This voucher, along with a modest fee, can be exchanged for one (1) all day ski ticket at Cannon Mountain.
- Families receiving special discounts or scholarships are still liable for race worker credits/fees.
- All "RACE WORKER SIGNUPS" will be on the bulletin board at Ernie's beginning at the mandatory safety meeting in December.
- **Sign up sheets will be finalized (typed) 2 weeks from race date and names will not** be allowed to be removed from the sheet from that date forward unless the individual has a named replacement.

**DISCOUNTS** on Regular Season Training Fees:

- o Multiple Racers in the Same Family: 3<sup>rd</sup> and subsequent racers are 30% off regular season fees.

**FAMILY MEMBERSHIP** includes both active and supportive families. Supportive memberships have no children participating in the program but have access to all FSC facilities, programs, events and communications.

**RACE WORKER FEE** obligations from last season *must* be satisfied before training can begin. The prepayment amount for Race Worker Fees for the upcoming season is \$900. Please read "RACE WORKER CREDITS" for more information.

**UNPAID TRAINING FEES** from last season must be satisfied before training can begin.

Limited **SCHOLARSHIPS** are given based on financial hardship, commitment and ability. Dependents of Cannon Mountain employees are eligible to apply for employee discounts at various rates. All applications must be completed by October 15, 2009.

**SKI LOCKERS** are available for \$250/year. Last year's lessees get first consideration then they will be available by random draw. **LAST YEAR LEASEES MUST COMMIT/PAY October 15<sup>th</sup>.**

## FSC RACER RULES OF BEHAVIOR

### Why does FSC have Rules of Behavior?

Being a racer in FSC and taking part in its programs and activities is a privilege and not a right. If you choose to disobey the Racer Rules of Behavior, either by putting yourself or others at risk, you may be suspended or expelled from FSC.

### What are the Rules of Behavior?

**All FSC racers will be honest, decent and sportsmanlike at all times. This means:**

- Being courteous and respectful to other racers, coaches, mountain employees and the skiing public;
- Being respectful of and following all decisions of the coaching staff, race officials and FSC officials;
- Following all ski area rules and signs; and
- Respect other people and their possessions.

**It also means that you:**

- Do not act recklessly;
- Do not put anyone else in danger;
- Do not use alcohol, tobacco or illegal drugs.

### What happens if YOU don't follow the Rules of Behavior?

- First Offense:** Your parents will be notified of the behavior.
- Second Offense:** Your parents, the FSC Program Director and the FSC President will be notified of the behavior. You will be removed from one day of training.
- Third Offense:** Your parents, the FSC Head Coach, the FSC President and the FSC Board of Directors will be notified of the behavior. You will be suspended and/or expelled from training and other FSC activities.
- Serious Offenses:** Those involving danger to yourself or others or illegal acts will result in your immediate suspension and/or expulsion from all FSC programs and activities without prior notice.

The FSC President, Program Director and coaches, individually, shall have full authority to take disciplinary action, and may take whatever action he or she deems appropriate in his or her sole discretion. If you are suspended from a program for more than one day you must reapply to the program. Training fees will not be refunded under any circumstances if you are expelled from a program.

**Application and Training fees** are due on October 15, 2009, any application received after that date will be assessed 20% surcharge. The club has always tried to work with families who need extra time to pay their training fees, please inquire about our **Hardship Policy** if you need a time extension. (Due date automatically extended for those families making application for a scholarship)

**Refunds** - Training fees will be refunded at 50% for those athletes withdrawing from the program prior to the first day of on-snow training at Cannon Mountain. No refunds will be available after that date. If an athlete suffers a season ending injury, a refund of 50% can be requested if before January 1<sup>st</sup> and accompanied by a doctor's note. Refunds apply to training fee only; family membership fee of \$100 is not refundable. If the injured athlete recovers and is cleared to ski at a later date, the refunded training fee must be repaid to the club prior to commencement of training. All approved refunds will be paid within 30 days.

**Athletes applying after the application deadline** of October 15<sup>th</sup> will be accepted at the discretion of the Program Director. We are always welcoming of athletes into our program, however; athlete to coach ratio is very important to the success of the club and adding an unexpected number of athletes can overload our coaching staff. Every effort will be made to accept anyone applying for membership.

**Returning ski club alumni/college athletes** are always welcome at the club. During the December holiday week we often see former FSC athletes and current college racers return for a few days of skiing and training. We love to have these great role models for our younger athletes to watch; however, you must first check-in with the Program Director for availability of training and sign the club's liability waiver.

**Mountain Employee Discounts** – Paid Cannon Mountain employees are eligible for a discount on FSC training fees. Full time employees receive a 50% discount and part time employees receive a 25% discount. The discount does not apply to the \$100 family membership fee.
